Colorado Law requires that you give your name and current address to a ski area employee before you leave the vicinity if you are enter closed lands adjoining a ski area. where you are visible from above and do not restrict traffic. Look uphill and avoid trails and out of closed areas. You must know how and be able to load, ride and unload lifts safely. If you need assistance, ask the lift attendant. Do not use lifts or terrain when impaired by alcohol or drugs. If you are involved in a collision or incic share your contact information with each other and a ski area employee. Winter sports involve risk of serious injury or death. Your knowledge, decisions and actions contribute to your safety and that of others. If you need help understanding the Code



Activities other than downhill skiing or snowboarding may be prohibited or restricted within the ski area. It is your responsibility to contact Winter Park senior management for details. NO SLEDDING ALLOWED. Skiing or riding with a child in a front or backpack is strongly discouraged. Inverted aerials not recommended.
