

Freestyle Devo Internal Competition Details (Day of Event)

This competition is held at Winter Park on the Devo Freestyle Mogul Course that has one jump (on Lower Parkway). This is a two-run competition where the athletes' participation is highly encouraged. The athletes can expect to inspect the course, warm up, and compete two runs. Awards per age group and gender will be at the bottom of the course at the conclusion of the event. This is a fun way to put the athletes "in the gate" to test their skills in a competitive setting!

Event dates: Sunday, January 30 and Sunday, March 6

Registration is for **current** Winter Park Freestyle Devo Team Athletes only. Please do not enter if you are not a current team member. *

Registration/Bib pick up: located inside the main level of the Balcony House.

Course: Lower Parkway

Competition Day Schedule:

8:00- 9:30am: Registration/Bib Pick up

8:30am: Lifts Open

8:30-8:45am: Course Inspection, Lower Parkway

8:45-10am: Mogul Training

10-10:15am: Slip and Course Maintenance

10:15am: Forerunners followed by First Run

12:15-1:00pm: Lunch/Course Maintenance

1-1:15pm: Slip and Course Maintenance

1:15pm: Second Run

Awards Ceremony. Awards per age group and gender will be at the bottom of the course at the conclusion of the event.

*If a Saturday athlete is skiing in the event on Sunday, you will be coached while you are on course, but when you are not skiing the course, you are on your own. Sunday groups: meet your coaches at 8:25am so that you can board the lift when it opens at 8:30am for inspection.

For safety purposes, no one is allowed on course if one is not a competitor, a volunteer, or an employee of the event.

This is a two-run event. The athletes should expect to turn in their bib at the bottom of the course after completion of their second run.

The run order will be the same for both runs, and it will go from youngest to oldest; the females in each age division will compete first and then the males in each age division will compete (age is determined by how old the athlete was on December 31, 2021):

U9 (8 year olds)

U11 (9-10 year olds)

U13 (11-12 year olds)

U15 (13 years old and older)
